Swedish Smorgasbord at the Dubois Headwaters Center, Saturday, June 13

Dubois, WY— Everyone is invited to join the citizens of Dubois at the community's annual Swedish Smorgasbord at the Dubois Headwaters Center on Saturday, June 13.

The smorgasbord features traditional Scandinavian food and live entertainment. The buffet-style dinner is served at 5 and 6 p.m.

Tickets for the 2009 Swedish Smorgasbord go on sale Friday, May 15 at the Dubois Museum, Dubois Chamber of Commerce, Headwaters Center, National Bighorn Sheep Interpretive Center, Water Wheel Gifts and Books and Two Ocean Books.

The Swedish Smorgasbord celebrates the Scandinavian heritage of the tie hacks (loggers) who cut railroad cross-ties in the national forest near Dubois for almost forty years. Each spring a smorgasbord was held to celebrate the end of winter and the beginning of a one-hundred mile "tie drive" (float) down the Wind River to the railroad terminal in Riverton.

For many years the smorgasbord was an annual event, but the tradition died out until 2004 when the smorgasbord was revived by the Dubois Museum Association.
